FUNDRAISING

The 2021 Cableway Charity Challenge is almost upon us and it's time to make sure that you have raised your minimum of R2,500 as undertaken by registering for the event. While sponsorship pledges will remain open throughout the event window, the minimum is required to secure your race pack at registration on Thursday 8 April. There are still many athletes who have not raised any funds and many that are still below the minimum so please reach out to friends and family and get those pledges in!

RACE REGISTRATION AND RACE PACKS

Race packs and final race registration will take place on **Thursday 8 April 2021 between 4pm and 6pm** at the lower Cable station on Tafelberg Road. Athletes will be required to present themselves, hand in their signed indemnity form ([download here](#)) and collect their race packs. Our team will also take this opportunity to verify that athletes have all the technological requirements in place.

EMBRACING TECHNOLOGY

One of the good things to come out of COVID-19 is a mass embracing of technology. The Cableway Charity Challenge was faced with the choice of not holding the event at all or accepting that things will need to be done differently in a COVID-19 climate. To this end, participants need to follow the instructions below to ensure that they are ready for the event. These are ESSENTIAL requirements and participants will not be able to compete without them.

There is a lot of detail below so please read carefully. [Download your summary check-list here](#) so that you don't miss anything.

WEBTICKETS

The Table Mountain Aerial Cableway Company will be issuing electronic Cable Cards to each participant via Webtickets. These digital cards are needed in order to access your free trip down after your completed lap and will be valid for limitless down trips during the event window. The card will also be your access to race refreshments from the kiosk. To facilitate this, participants are required to have a Webtickets profile through which they can receive their free 9-day Cable Card. It is imperative that the email address and cell phone number of your Webtickets account corresponds to the email address and cell phone number you have used to register for the CCC2021 event.

Please visit www.webtickets.co.za to register an account or check that your existing account has the correct email and telephone number linked to it.

Once you have a Webtickets account with email address and cell number corresponding to our records, you will need to complete the google form [Charity Challenge Google Form](#) and upload a picture of yourself for the digital card. This needs to be completed by the end of Tuesday 6 April 2021 to give the Cableway team enough time to load your digital card onto your Webtickets account free of charge. Athletes can store this on their device for use electronically or print it out and carry it with them.

STRAVA

As you know we will be monitoring and recording your completed laps using STRAVA. STRAVA is a free to use App available on Google play (Google Play - STRAVA) and Apple App store (Apple Store - STRAVA).

Many of you already have STRAVA profiles and some will even notice a request from Cableway Charity Challenge to follow you when you login to your profile. If this is the case, please do accept the follow request and follow Cableway Charity Challenge back.

For those that do not yet have a STRAVA profile, please urgently set one up by downloading the App and following the process to register a profile. If possible, please use the same email address for your STRAVA account as you have used to register for the CCC2021 event. The process is self-explanatory but you are welcome to drop me a line if you require any assistance.

Once you have a profile, please follow this link ([Cableway Charity Challenge - STRAVA profile](#)) to the Cableway Charity Challenge (CCC) STRAVA profile and "Follow" it. CCC will then request to follow you back – please accept this request. Please complete this step by the end of Tuesday 6 April 2021.

On the day/s that you complete your ascents, you will need to record a **RUN** activity with STRAVA. The easiest way to accomplish this is to record it on your mobile device as follows:

- open the App on your phone
- ensure that you are logged in under your profile
- at the start of your lap, press the Record button at the bottom of the screen
- a map of your current location will appear
- tap the shoe button just above the start button
- make sure the activity is set to RUN (please do not choose walk or hike even if you aren't running the route)
- press START to begin recording
- press the orange stop button at the end of your lap and select FINISH and Save Activity

If you are using a fitness device to record your laps, please test that your activities are being uploaded correctly BEFORE you begin the event.

For record purposes (and also to save device battery life), we have set up a CCC2021 Segment ([CCC2021 Run](#)) and only the actual ascent up Platteklip needs to be recorded. STRAVA will automatically add your **RUN** activity to the CCC2021 Segment Leader Board each time you complete that particular segment.

At the end of each event day a Leader Board will be published across our communication platforms.

WHATSAPP

The CCC Team have set up a dedicated WhatsApp line on 0712970785. Please save this number to your contacts so that you receive the daily Leader Board updates and other important information via Broadcast Group. (Unlike groups, contacts that are in a broadcast list cannot see each other (in the list) and messages sent through the feature are delivered to each individual separately. Any reply to a broadcast goes directly to the original sender and other members in the list are not able to see it.)
